Tournament pass will be \$16.00. Saturday-Sunday pass \$12.00; Daily Pass \$8.00.

Coaches passes will be issued to AAU registered bench personnel listed on the roster at the tournament headquarters in the Coral Springs Gymnasium. The use of a coaches pass requires the non-uniformed person on the bench to comply with the dress code as stated below.

Roster must be presented to the Tournament Director prior to tournament play. During tournament, the Tournament Director will be located at the Coral Springs Gymnasium location or you can fax information to (954) 720-6131 no later than Thursday June 3, 3004.

All non-uniformed persons on the bench shall wear slacks, shirts with collars and sleeves, and dress shoes or tennis shoes during play at the Super Regional Championship. Shorts, jeans, sweat pants, athletic wear, tee shirts, hats, and open-toed shoes are not permitted. The dress code applies to female bench personnel as well. Women may wear dresses or skirts appropriate to the occasion.
